Standing on the bus: why, when and how

Standing room is how capacity on buses is maximised world-wide.


Standing is permitted on the lower part of a GO GEORGE bus floor in the midi and standard buses, but not allowed in minibuses.

A midi- or standard-size bus is not full until all the seats are taken AND full standing capacity has been reached. See below the info boxes showing the permitted passenger numbers which are also displayed in each bus.

During peak travel periods, passengers are encouraged to use standing space in the bus as this will help you reach your destination sooner, rather than waiting for the next bus with available seats to arrive.

VERY IMPORTANT:

Passengers must stand behind the yellow line on the floor behind the driver. No passengers are allowed in the front cabin where they could easily be injured, while also blocking the driver's view.



THINK ABOUT THIS!

If you are going to stand anyway, why not stand on the bus on route to your destination, rather than standing at the bus stop waiting for a bus with available seats
